April Board Meeting Minutes: Motion to approve as written by Tina S., 2nd by Diana M., motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: No report.

Advocacy: Tina S. FCOG Trails Plan for Fresno County being planned. She will let us know dates and times. She urges club member participation. This will be planning for mixed use trails and connections for existing trails.

AB1256 is going through the legislature. Passage will make it legal for cyclists to go straight in a right turn lane. Right now, cyclists can go straight if there is a bike lane pocket, but if none, have to take the right through lane. William has added a link to the website for contacts for bike lane maintenance issues.

Kirch Flat Ride May 4: Yvonne M.: 201 registered as of today. They will find out which ride the riders picked at packet pickup, as it was not on the registration form. There will be a shaved ice truck at the end. SAG and rest stops are manned. Tickets will be given at packet pickup for the taco truck and shaved ice at the end of the ride. The t-shirts and medals are in. Discussion about what to give the KOM and QOM and it was decided a free entry to a future ride would be awarded.

BLDC: Dennis B.: Jerseys are on order. It will be the same route and same hotel as last year.

C2K: Dennis B.: June 22. He is dealing with permits and route issues. The final route will be announced prior to the ride. He will ask for volunteers through a volunteer Facebook page and the internet site link.

Approve Donation for Kids Bike Helmets: Tina S.: There is a Bike Rodeo in the Tower District on May 18. This is a program for child and adult bike safety. There is information on the website. She proposes donating \$250.00 for helmets. Motion made by Janet L., 2nd by Henry P. Motion Passed.

Approve Donation for Bikes for Pine Ridge School: Tina S.: Pine Ridge School representative asked about a donation of bikes for a drawing at the end of the year for attendance, etc. (They allow us the use of their site for C2K). It was suggested we donate for 3 bikes not to exceed \$500.00. Motion made by Henry P., 2nd by Janet L. Motion Passed.

Ride of Silence: Dennis: Melissa Rose has volunteered to lead it this year. The ride will start at Steven's Bicycles meeting at 6:30 and leaving at 7 pm. The ride and route will be added to the ride calendar.

Shop to Shop Ride: Dennis and Tina: Tina has gone to the bike shops and they were receptive to hosting such a ride. She will work on a route and date. FCC will provide refreshments. Perhaps a poker ride with cards? Tentative date set at May 25.

Tour de Lakes: Dennis B.: July 27. He is still looking for a ride director.

New Business: Henry P. has access to the Adahi Campgrounds (no services, but has porta pottys) located at Sky Ranch Road near Nelder Grove. He suggests an FCC campout Labor Day weekend for camping and gravel bike riding. August 31-September 2.

Dennis: Suggested a donation of \$1,000 for the radio group. They donate their time, equipment and expertise for our multiple events and never charge us. Motion made by Janet L, 2nd by Tina S. Motion Passed.

Dennis and Diana D. brought up issues regarding reinforcing strict time cutoffs on our event rides to accommodate the volunteers.
