**Treasurer's Report:** No report. Elida Gonzalez not present.

**Advocacy:** No report. Tina Sumner not present.

**C2K Recap**: Dennis Ball: 2020 date set for June 27. Diana Dean prepared a C2K Debrief meeting summary for use in planning next year's event. Due to confusion and wrong turns by cyclists in the beginning, the need for a lead out from this point forward was very apparent. Dennis will look into Funeral Escort type lead out for 2020. Robert Firestine mentioned he has a connection to a Funeral Escort service if desired.

**Tour de Lakes:** Gia Parker not present. Joe Cassinerio will work with the Killer Bee's at the McKinley Grove rest stop. Diana Dean waiting on Gia's approval of Volunteer sign up sheet before creating link on Volunteersignup.org.

**Bass Lake Double Century:** Angelo Quitorio: Event date – Oct 12, 2019. Volunteer ride set for Oct 5<sup>th</sup>. This is their 15<sup>th</sup> year! Registration for Double is slow but it's still early. Dennis Ball mentioned and Angelo accepted Diana Dean as the volunteer coordinator for the event.

Pines Resort is allowing the use of their park area adjacent to the parking lot again and at no charge to FACT/FCC. Pepsi returning as a sponsor. They will provide water and sodas. Hammer is donating \$1000 in product. Dennis suggested more electrolytes. Giordana will be the kit supplier again and will be making some sort of donation towards the event.

Need to work with Madera on obtaining the 168 permit. Angelo working on a design concept for the tshirts. FACT has chosen a Halloween type theme this year.

**Multisport Mixer:** Diana Millhollin & Edward Gonzalez: Diana Millhollin shared that the Multisport Mixer is an avenue for all types of athletes (ie: runners, cyclists, tri-athletes) to connect. They promote FCC and it's events and as a result, FCC has experienced some new memberships.

Edward Gonzalez (Active Life Insurance & a sponsor of Multisport) mentioned their new venue at Vino Grille & Spirits brought in a record 61 people this past week. The Grille is closed on Mondays but is opening for this private event each month. Edward presented FCC with the opportunity to become one of the sponsors of this mixer at the sponsorship rate of \$100/month.

Diana Millhollin will continue promoting the mixer through the FCC website, Rough Draft and Facebook groups. She will also provide FCC items for the mixer's monthly free raffles. Other FCC raffle ideas mentioned were: 1 year free FCC membership; free registration to an FCC event (picnic, holiday party); or free registration for a ride (Kirch Flats, Tour de Lakes, etc).

**Grizzly Century:** Dennis Ball: Event date – September 14, 2019. Dennis mentioned that historically the North Fork community has provided the volunteers but this year FCC will probably need to cover the Registration and SAG. He will give Diana Dean a list of volunteer positions FCC will need to fill so we can start recruiting for those.

**C2K, Tollhouse Century & Millerton Metric as 2 separate events:** Dennis Ball: Dennis announced that C2K and Tollhouse will not be split in 2020 but the Millerton Metric would be better placed with the Killer Bee Swarm on a different date. July was mentioned as a possibility.

**New Business - FCC Annual Picnic:** Diana Millhollin: Date set for August 24, 2019 at Railroad Park on Peach & Alluvial in Clovis. Vernon with the FACT team will provide his BBQ trailer.

**New Business – Active Life Insurance Solutions**: Edward Gonzalez: Edward would like to create a strategic alliance between his company and FCC members. He can provide discounts for group enrollments of 10 or more. Edward would also like his insurance company (Active Life) to be listed on the FCC website as a club supporter under the Rider Resources link. Dennis Ball connected Edward with Bill Reddington to be added to the FCC website.

**New Business - FCC Kit Design Ideas:** Dennis Ball.: Dennis is still looking for ideas for a new FCC kit.
