Advocacy: Tina S.:There will be a public meeting of the Clovis Active Transportation Plan on 2/10/22 at 6 p.m. She says to check Appendix A and get comments to her before the meeting, sign on to the virtual meeting or send comments to the host. Will document a year-long project adopted in March. Also on 2/10/22 the Fresno City Council is hosting an event and proclamation ride downtown. It will start at 10 am at Manchester Center and ride downtown with a police escort.

Long-time, experienced ride leaders will be needed as trainers. Suggestion to hold at the Red Caboose at Belmont and Academy in March or early April.

New Business: Discussion regarding waivers. Suggestion to have an all-inclusive waiver included on every renewal as well as waivers on all ride registrations. Also to add waivers to the website that can be pulled up for an electronic signature by ride leaders.
