Meeting Opened: 6:39 PM, called to order by President Dennis Ball

May Board Meeting Minutes: Read and motion to approve with minor change to page 3 to read "Facebook Messenger Board Member Communication" by Joe C., 2nd by Henry P., approved.

The bulk of the expenses are for Kirch Flat (\$3,434.91)

The rest are standard charges for porta pottys, costs for schools for C2K, software.

The deposits are a combination of Kirch Flat, C2K and membership.

Advocacy Report: John McCracken: We may need to design an alternative route for Kirch Flat and C2K in 2019 due to road work projects. He will be making an Excel spreadsheet outlining the road work projected in 2019.

John is working on building relationships to get better timelines and project notifications. He will work on City and County project spreadsheets to see how they affect the timing of events so alternative routes can be planned.

June 13th Time Trial: Patty D.: 45 riders last month. 3 volunteers needed to be available at 5 pm for 5:30 start time.

Tour de Lakes: Henry P.: We had issues last year regarding setting up the radio contacts in the parking lot. SoCal Edison had some concerns. Dennis will obtain a permit and already has a contact there. Henry encourages everyone to use the Community Center parking lot. Lori Cherry will run the rest stop. The date is Saturday, July 28.

C2K and Grizzly Century Updates: C2K: Dennis B.: The Sheriffs' Department did not feel we could make C2K safe enough for riders and suggested we move the date. They would not sign off on the permit for June 30, so we really had no choice. The new date for C2K is July 7. At this time the start/finish is at Clovis East High School. We lost 12 riders due to the date change and Dennis issued refunds. We have 45 riders pre-registered.

There will be a volunteer meeting on June 20 at Stevens Bicycles, Clovis. He has a coin designed for finishers at \$4 a piece cost. He is still considering whether to purchase them. He has 40 volunteers signed up.

We need to decide on the date for next year: June 22 or June 29. Ken H. advised historically it is whatever date is closest to the 21st of June, which would make the date June 22.

Grizzly: Dennis B.: 29 people are signed up. Breakfast is a \$6.00 separate charge. The after ride meal is included in the entry. North Fork group is manning the rest stops and assisting with SAG. The Lions Club is doing the pancake breakfast. The North Fork committee is doing the after ride meal. \$10 charge for non-riders for the after ride meal.

Kirch Flat Recap: Mike Q. and Yvonne Moreno: We had approximately 270 riders; the largest entry yet. They had positive feedback from riders. They may have timing next year. They are already in the planning stages for next year.

May is Bike Month Recap: Dennis B.: Dennis asked for suggestions and recommendations for next year. Tina Sumner suggested more encouraging wording on the website to promote the different events that month.

There was the Million Mile Challenge (IBike Fresno); the Mall to Mall Ride and the Ride of Silence. We could see if we can get City Hall more involved. Put a suggestion section on the website for possible events and activities for next year.

Storage Unit Cleanup/Organize: Dennis B.: Diana Dean and her husband volunteered to be Quartermaster to clean up, organize and monitor the storage unit. Diana was added as a Board Member, as this is a board position. She will advise if she needs a work day and volunteers.

Gravel Grinder: Patty D. : The date for Everyone Loves Raymond Gravel Grinder is Saturday, November 17. There will be two distances called the Pint and the Half-Pint. There will be a 7 a.m. start time. The Pint will be 80 miles and the Half-Pint will be 33-35 miles. Her committee will be working on marketing, flyers, etc. There will be a lot of dirt roads, so will be looking for off-road motorcyclists as SAG.

Brevets: Lori C.: The 600K Brevet is this weekend. All riders had to pre-register. She has 11 riders and volunteers.

New Business:

The July 4 meeting was change to July 3. Dennis will check on the location.
